CONFERENCE VENUE

The first day of the conference will be held in the palace ensemble in Obrzycko (about 50 km from Poznań), build at the beginning in the 20th century, which was owned by noble Polish family Raczyński. Nowadays in the facility the House of Creative Work and Leisure of Adam Mickiewicz University is located. It is situated in a picturesque setting - on the edge of the Warta Valley surrounded by an old park.

The second day of the conference will start with meeting in the Town Hall of Poznań, which is a historical building settled by Jesuit College in 1701-1703. After the meeting the Poznań Metropolitan Area excursion is planned.

THE POSTSYMPOSIUM FIELD TRIP
